iHEAL targets 5,000 to sign up for "OurCheckup platform"

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 12 (Bernama) -- iHEAL Heart Group Sdn Bhd is targeting to sign up 5,000 users, within a year, for its new online platform called "OurCheckup" that will store data on a patient's heart, says chairman and group managing director Dr David Khoo Sin Keat.

He said the cloud-based platform, to be launched on April 7 in conjunction with World Health Day, would be accessible to patients and their doctors, allowing them to easily secure and share data.

"At the moment, we are finalising the price for the application. We want to make it affordable and accessible to all," he told reporters after Deputy Minister of Health Dr Lee Boon Chye launched "OurCheckup" here today.
